
## Volume 4, Appendix 9 PARENT SCALES FOR PIANO: WHOLE TONE

**Whole tone 1** The whole tone scale on C uses three white keys plus three black keys.



## **G major** The whole tone scale on D<sub>b</sub> uses two black keys plus four white keys.
