and the | people with his truth.

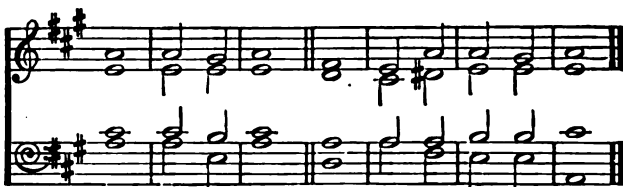
Glory be to the Father and | to the Son:
